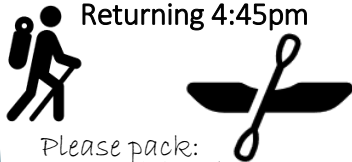

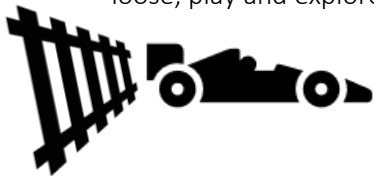

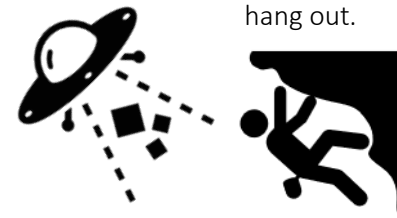
Hyperdrive, Pancake Train and Dru Point Reserve
