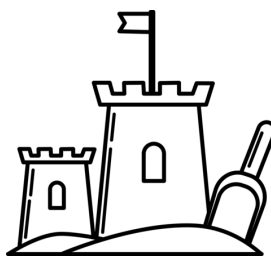

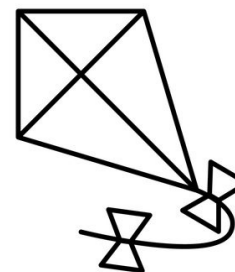

In the afternoon we will have the opportunity to challenge ourselves on the slack line and create our own candles using the candle maker.

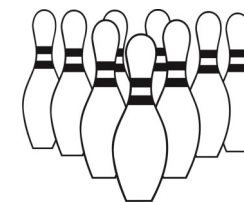
